Home Groups | Week 3 | January 28, 2018 Wrestling with God | Genesis 27:1-40

Icebreaker:

Have you played a trick or practical joke on someone, or has someone played a trick on you pretending to be someone else?

Questions:

- 1. Rebekah had been told in Genesis 25 that the older would serve the younger. Yet she and her son Jacob are deceptive to get the father's blessing. What does this reveal about their character and their trust in God?
- 2. How would you describe this family of four: as "religious"? as "Godly"? as "dysfunctional"? as "sinful"? What do you think was our Creator's original intent for the family? What's happened?
- 3. In Genesis 27:30-40, we see an amazing scene. Can you picture that scene? When Esau found that Jacob had stolen his father's blessing, he was very upset. Have you ever held a grudge against someone or been resentful of their actions? Were you able to forgive them?
- 4. In verses 34-40, Esau cried and wept aloud. In your imagination, how does Esau appear? With what words did Isaac "bless" Esau? What is telling about this "prediction"? Was Isaac's a blessing or a curse? Why do you think so?
- 5. How do you deal with someone taking advantage of you? What is the best, most Godly way, to handle those situations?
- 6. Whose blessing or approval is, or has been, most important to you? Why? Is there someone whose blessing you always wanted, but never received?
- 7. Who can you impact with a "blessing?" How would you plan to do so?
- 8. What from this passage is a "word of the Lord to you"? What, if anything, are you to do?


