### Lenten Banners

The banners hanging on the Sanctuary walls contain images that point to the historical events of Lent and Holy Week. The initials INRI (Latin: *Iēsus Nazārēnus, Rēx Iūdaeōrum*) represent the Latin inscription (as in John 19:19), which in English translates to *Jesus the Nazarene, King of the Jews*, and John 19:20 states that this was written in three languages—Hebrew, Latin, and Greek—during the crucifixion of Jesus.

Revelation 19:4-9, Zephaniah 3:14-18,

Building for God's Kingdom | Celebration

and Luke 15

#### Icebreaker:

What is your favorite celebration of the year? Is it birthdays, Christmas, or another special occasion to you or your family?

1. Revelation 19 talks about an incredibly loud celebration of what God has done in the world. If you could have a loud celebration about one thing that God has done for you, what would it be?
2. Some see Christianity as a set of rules to follow and see God as one who makes the rules. How might this view inhibit our ability to celebrate? What in Revelation 19:4-9 or Zephaniah 3:14-18 might help us see God as more than a rule-maker and make us want to rejoice and celebrate?
3. In Zephaniah 3, God rejoices and sings over his people. Do you believe that God delights in you? Do you believe that God enjoys you? Why or why not?
4. Celebrations in Luke 15 are more extravagant than efficient. Do you find it easier to be extravagant or efficient?
5. Who is someone whom God has used in extraordinary ways to make a big impact in your life? What was that impact and how might you celebrate it?
6. What is one practical way the church in general and ZPC specifically could celebrate more? What is one practical way you as an individual, with your family or with your home group could celebrate God's work?
