HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 2 | 1.21.24
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 19:1-9

What person (family not included) would you run or climb a tree to see?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

1. On Sunday, we asked you what word or phrase you noticed as we read through the passage. Share with those in your group what you noticed.
2. How does Zacchaeus compare to the rich young ruler (Luke 18:18-30) in his approach and response to Jesus?
3. Jesus was en route to Jerusalem. Why "must" Jesus stay with Zacchaeus?
4. What do you think Jesus meant in vs. 9 when he says "Today salvation has come to this house because this man, too, is a son of Abraham"? In what ways do you relate to Zacchaeus and the ways he might have felt alienated? In what ways do you relate to the Jews and how they might have felt toward Zacchaeus?
5. While we don't fully know what happened, discuss why you think Zacchaeus made such a big change once Jesus came to his house.
6. Is it hard for you to get the noise of our society (as well as that within our own selves) out of our ears so that we can see and hear God? What practices, if any, do you engage in to help you see God more easily?
