Week 3 | 1.28.24
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 19:11-27

What is the best financial investment you ever made? Or the worst?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

1. What was the context of this parable? (Where is Jesus heading to and about to arrive?) What is the parable's basic message? Are you encouraged or discouraged by this parable? Why?
2. The citizens sent a delegation that said, "We do not want this man to rule over us." This leads to a question of what is it that rules over us? Are there parts of our lives that we like Jesus to rule over us and parts that we would like keep to ourselves?
3. The mina was a basic standard of weight of money in Jesus' time. The king gives ten minas to three servants. They come back to the king with an extra 10, 5 or 0 minas. Which of these three servants would you most relate to and why?
4. The last servant hid his master's money or gift. Why did the servant hide it? Is fear ever a motive in your relationship with Christ? Why or why not?
5. Characterize the king: Do you like him? Why or why not? According to the passage and Sunday's message, who might the king represent?
6. What talents or resources have you been given "to work with"? Are you "working it well"? Why do you think so?
