The season of Lent is a time set aside in the church for spiritual renewal and growing in faith. On Ash Wednesday, which kicks off the Lenten season, we seek a fresh start by saying yes to the Lord's invitation to walk with him. Though we bring plenty of baggage on our journey, Jesus reminds us that his yoke is easy and his burden is light asking only that we set our hearts on him. This is the goal of our Lenten season: setting our whole selves – heart and mind, body and soul – in complete trust and utter commitment on the Triune God. Make plans to join us on Ash Wednesday at 12 or 6 pm.

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

**Week 4 | 2.4.24
Seeing Jesus Anew**

**Scripture:
Luke 19:28-48**

Group Gathering Question:

When have you ever been in a parade? What was it like? Do you like parades, why or why not?

Read this week's scripture and discuss:

1. Jesus arriving in Jerusalem is often called the "triumphal entry." In what sense was Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem triumphal? In what sense was it not triumphal?
2. What kind of reception would Jesus get if he rode into your town today? What might the reception be on social media, for elected officials, and from the people on the streets?
3. Do you think the Pharisees in this scene were against Jesus or were trying to make sure he (or perhaps themselves) didn't get in trouble with the authorities?
4. What does Jesus mean in verse 40 when he says, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out." Read Habakkuk 2:11 for more insight.
5. This passage contains the joy of worship, but also the tears and pain of loving like Jesus does. When you are struggling or suffering do you find worship to be something you are drawn to or something that you struggle with either because you are confused about God or because you feel the pressure to act like you are happy?
6. How has Jesus "turned over tables" in your life or of those around you?
