HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 6 | 2.18.24 **Scripture:**
Seeing Jesus Anew **Luke 20:27-40**

Group Gathering Question:
Jesus was considered a rabbi or a teacher. He confronts these teachers of the law. Can you think of a favorite teacher or perhaps a least favorite teacher that you had?

- Read this week's scripture and discuss:**
1. Here in Luke 20, Jesus is questioned by the Sadducees. In the last several chapters of Luke, Jesus is almost constantly questioned, nearly interrogated, by religious leaders. How do you think Jesus is able to hold up under this pressure, especially during the week he will go to the cross?
 2. The Sadducees come up with an implausible scenario in order to ask Jesus a question about resurrection. Do you find yourself wondering about resurrection or what Heaven will be like? What questions do you have?
 3. How should we handle and respond to hard questions (whose wife will she be in Heaven?) and hard answers (people in the resurrection life will not marry)? How do you handle difficult questions from people you love or even people you don't love?
 4. Jesus talks about resurrection in verses 34-38. How do you view the resurrection life? How do you feel when Jesus says that people will not marry in the next age?
 5. How does Jesus "prove" the resurrection in verses 37-38? What does it mean to you when Jesus says that God is God of the living, not God of the dead?
