HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 8 | 3.3.24
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 21:5-38

Group Gathering Question:

Luke 21 says that the temple is described as adorned with beautiful stones. What is the tallest building or most beautiful building that you've ever visited?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss:

1. How does it feel to read what Jesus says in verses 5-11? What will happen when the temple's stones will be thrown down?
2. Now how does it feel to read what Jesus says in verses 12-19 about his disciples being persecuted? Do you think that Christians today need to be concerned about the kind of persecution Jesus talks about here?
3. While Christians in the early church were persecuted, how has the church persecuted or hurt others in the last 2000 years? How might remembering the faults of the church historically make us more sympathetic to those who see the world differently than us today?
4. When you feel unsafe or insecure to where does your heart or mind go?
5. What event has occurred in your life that has revealed ways in which you put your trust and hope in things that are not eternal?
6. In the midst of the heavy news, how does Jesus caution his followers (verses 34-36)? In the world today (with the stress of news, social media and politics), how do you deal with things?
