HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 9 | 3.10.24

Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:

Luke 22:1-38

Group Gathering Question:

What are the special meals in your family? Thanksgiving? Christmas? Easter? Sunday dinners or birthdays?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

1. In verse 15, Jesus says he has eagerly desired to be with his disciples. Is it easy or difficult for you to think that God desires to be with you? If it is difficult, what makes it so?
2. Jesus transforms the understanding of the Passover meal to the Last Supper. Today, we celebrate it as the Lord's Supper or Communion. What does Communion mean to you? Does reading this passage in Luke make you feel any differently?
3. In verses 23-24, the disciples wonder who will betray Jesus then quickly move to arguing over who will be the greatest among them. What does this tell us about the disciples?
4. What is Jesus' response to the disciples' dispute about who is the greatest? How do you see people today who are great in the world's eyes as compared to someone who is a quiet servant and truly great?
5. In verse 32 Jesus says "But I have prayed for you, Simon (Peter), that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." Do you think this prayer was realized? Why or why not? What does it say that Jesus said this right before he told Peter that he would deny him 3 times?
6. See Jesus' instructions in verses 36 and 37. How are they different from the ways the disciples traveled previously (see verse 35)? What is Jesus telling them with these instructions? If you were the disciples, how would you be feeling about this shift? Which of these ways of traveling do you think Jerry would be most comfortable with?
