HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 1 | 4.7.24

Scripture: Revelation 4 & 5

Group Gathering Question:

In Revelation 5, we see 24 elders sing and then thousands of angels sing. What is the best choir or musical group you have ever heard (or participated in)?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

1. The book of Revelation is a different book - it is apocalyptic - "revealing" truth about Jesus for that time period and giving hope for the future. What is your comfort level with Revelation? How might Revelation impact the understanding of your faith?
2. The author John says he sees through a door standing open in heaven in Revelation 4. Name and discuss some of the things he sees here in this chapter. Who do you think sits on the throne? Why do you think there is lightning and thunder?
3. Read what the creatures and the elders say in verses Revelation 4:8-11. Do you recognize this kind of language in our songs or in our prayers today? Do those words (seen here in a vision of heaven) have meaning for you or provoke feelings in you?
4. We see in Revelation 5:5 the Lion of the tribe of Judah. Who is the Lion? Why is he able to open the scroll and its seven seals?
5. Who is the Lamb in Revelation 5:6? What is the significance of a lamb in scripture? How are the Lion and the Lamb the same person? What might that mean to you in your life?
6. Our guest preacher, Rev. Ben Davison from Second Presbyterian Church, talked about how worship teaches us who we are and how we ought to live in the world. Worship also extends into the ordinary places of our lives where we live, work and play. Do you agree or disagree? How might you see worship teaching us about how we ought to live in the world?
