HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 2 | 4.14.24
Seeing Jesus Anew

Scripture:
Luke 24:13-35

Group Gathering Question:

Luke 24 says the two disciples on the road to Emmaus looked sad. When you're really down, do you want to be alone or with others?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

1. What are the two travelers talking about on the road to Emmaus? What tones of voice do you hear in their words? What hopes have been dashed?
2. Why didn't they recognize Jesus when he joined them? What opened their eyes? Why would Jesus use this way to show himself?
3. Why do you think Jesus used a verbal walk through the Bible (see verses 25-27) instead of simply identifying himself immediately?
4. How would you describe your "walk" with Jesus right now? What does the resurrected Jesus need to do in your life?
5. Just as he appears to two disciples on the road to Emmaus, Jesus appears post-resurrection several other times to different groups of people. What do you think it would have been like if you had been among those who had seen him? How would it have impacted your life going forward?
6. When we talk about being able to see the risen savior in our world today (or another way to put it is seeing God at work), what does that mean to you? Is this something that you feel like you experience or not?
7. As we consider the journey that helped the disciples finally recognize the resurrected savior who was in their midst, are there practices that you engage in that help you to experience God? Are there things in your life that you think inhibit you from seeing Jesus more at work in your life?
