HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 6 | 5.12.24

Ephesians: The Surprising Church

Scripture:

Ephesians 2:1-10

Group Gathering Question:

Ephesians 2:8 says we have a gift from God. What is a recent gift of any kind that you have received? Share about that gift with your group.

Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

1. Paul says we were dead in our sin. Tim Keller says, "Sin isn't only doing bad things, it is more fundamentally making good things into ultimate things. Sin is building your life and meaning on anything, even a very good thing, more than on God. Whatever we build our life on will drive us and enslave us. Sin is primarily idolatry." Consider this definition of sin, what is something in your life you struggle with building your life on rather than on God?
2. Can you remember a time when you, as Ephesians 2:2 reads in the Message, "let the world tell you how to live?" If so, what was that like? What is the alternative and how is that different?
3. In this passage, Paul divides a Christian's life into two periods. What are they? What or who would a person follow in the first period? What is the result?
4. The word grace appears three times in this short passage. According to what you read here, what does the word grace mean?
5. Looking at verses 8-10, what is the relationship between grace and good works?
6. Verse 10 says "For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we may walk in them." Has there been a time in your life when it was clear that what you were participating in was something that God had prepared beforehand for you to do?
