## the details

**Location:** Lavanneau (pronounced LA Van No), Haiti

**Date:** July 19-27, 2017

**Cost:** Approximately \$1,700\* (depending on accommodation choice)

**Shots:** Some shots recommended; Cholera is potentially an issue

## the work

- » Conduct Vacation Bible School for 500-550 students in the mornings.
- » Provide morning Bible study for adults.
- » Construction projects.
- » Distribute donated shoes and clothing.
- » Evangelizing with the community through evening worship, study and visiting homes.

## the trip

- » Hotel accommodations with air conditioning can sleep 1-3 or stay on property in missionary house.
- » We will take shoes, clothing, school supplies, VBS supplies and food supplies.
- » Pack above items in old suitcases that can be left in Haiti. The Haitians can use these as dressers to protect their clothes from dust.
- » Food is local, may want to bring your own food if you are particular.
- » Be prepared for a 2-3 hour drive from the airport.
- » Climate is very similar to Florida, will be hot and humid in July.
- » Will traverse river in vehicle to get to Lavanneau, not a problem unless it rains too much.
- » Informational meetings will occur in February and March.
