the work

» They will work with Cedaridge, a Christian Ministry. Cedaridge provides food, clothing, other necessities, and spiritual guidance to the poor and homeless in Southeastern Kentucky. Projects may include light construction, helping at a local thrift store, and food pantry.

the trip

- » Leave from ZPC on Friday morning, October 13 for Kentucky. Zionsville school families have the option of taking Friday off school to travel with the group or meet us later in the day. The drive is approximately 5 hours. Our return will be after breakfast on Monday, October 16.
- » The group will stay at Laurel Lake Baptist Camp. Rooms are equipped with private bathrooms and are large enough for whole families to stay together.
- » All meals are provided by the camp.
- » Fellowship, daily devotionals, singing & s'mores happen nightly by a roaring campfire beneath a starlit sky.
- » On Sunday, families will worship together at a local rural, country church that Cedaridge serves.
- » This is a great opportunity for families to serve together.
