V.5-6 Jesus stopped:

- **Looking up**
 - **Come down ... it is necessary**
 - **He received Him with joy**

Vs.7-10 Those watching and Zacchaeus

- **Eating with a sinner**
- **Standing**
 - **Half to the poor**
 - **Repay four times**
- **Today salvation to this house**
 - **Because ...**

Key words/ thoughts: **Zacchaeus** (Ζακχαῖος: Zechariah); **fig/mulberry tree** (συκομωραία); **come down** (καταβαίνω); **hasten** (σπεύδω); **chief tax collector** (ἀρχιτελώνης); **it is necessary** (δεῖ); **remain** (μένω); **welcome** (ἀποδέχομαι); **Lord** (κύριος); **murmur (among selves)** (διαγογγύζω); **defraud** (συκοφαντέω: “fig informer”)
