Jesus approaches Jerusalem

- **He sends two of His disciples**
 - **His instructions**
 - **Its Master has need**
 - **Just as He said**

Vs. 35-40

Jesus lifted upon the colt

- **As He descended**
 - **Their garments**
 - **They rejoice and praise**
 - **Psalm 18 (King)**
 - **Luke 2**
- **Rebuke your disciples**
- **The stones will cry out**

Vs. 41-44

He “weeps”

- **If you knew ...**
 - **The days will come**
 - **Your enemies will ...**

Vs. 45-48

He enters the Temple

- **He “removes”**
 - **He quotes**
- **Day-by-day**
 - **They sought**
 - **The people ...**

Key words/ thoughts: Lord/masters (κύριος); colt (πῶλος King (βασιλεὺς); rebuke (ἐπιτιμᾶω); be silent (βοᾶω); scream (κράζω); weep (κλαίω); raze (ἐδαφίζω); barricade (χάραξ); encircle (περικυκλώω); hem in (συνέχω); visitation (ἐπισκοπή); cast out (ἐκβάλλω); robber (ληστής)
